## What is *TwinLife*?

- DFG-funded long-term project
- Aim: The study of genetic and social causes of life chances and social inequality
- Design: genetically informative, longitudinal, crosssequential Extended Twin Family Design
- Social inequality conceptualized as a multi-dimensional phenomenon including six inequality domains
- Detailed assessment of a variety of environmental factors
